

Childcare & Preschool Health Policy Posting

The Health Department regulations prohibit the admittance of any child into a childcare facility that exhibits any of the following symptoms:

☐ Fever (101°f or higher) — child needs to be fever free for 24 hours without the
aid of medication
☐ Diarrhea – If diarrhea starts at daycare you will be called after the third
occurrence to pick up your child. Your child should not return until symptom
free for 24 hours without the aid of medication
☐ Vomiting – child must be symptom free for 24 hours without the aid of
medication
☐ Runny nose with colored discharge – check with doctor
□ Rash – check with doctor
☐ Discharge from eyes or ears
☐ Lice – child needs to be treated and nits removed before return
☐ Communicable Diseases – chicken pox, measles, mumps, conjunctivitis (pink
eye), influenza etc. The child may return when the incubation and contagious
period is passed and the child is well enough to resume normal childcare
activities.

## Medication

If your child is on antibiotics he/she continues to be contagious for 24 hours after the first dose of medication and can't return to childcare until this time period has passed.

Childcare regulations prohibit BOHRN TO ACHIEVE staff from giving your child medication of any kind unless you have filled out and signed a <u>Permission to Administer Medication Form</u>. All medication must be in the original, labeled container.
